Bath High School Teams Up with Local Public Safety Agencies Ahead of Prom

On Wednesday, May 10, 2017 the Bath High School Interact Club, in conjunction with the Bath Twp. Fire Department, Ohio State Highway Patrol, Allen County Sheriff's Office, and the Lima-Allen County Safe Community Coalition will conduct youth safe driver education programs at Bath High School.

At 7:45 A.M., as students arrive at school, they will be rewarded with free ice cream coupons courtesy of McDonald's for wearing their seat belts. Those students found to be driving without a seat belt will be issued a "ticket" by their fellow students.

During the school day, an *"Impaired/Distracted Driving Simulator"* will be used to put Bath High School students "behind the wheel" in a simulated situation to allow them to see the dangers of both impaired and distracted driving.

The Interact Club is a student led organization with a mission to provide helpful service to its school and community. It is sponsored by the Lima Rotary Club.
