Bath Township Fire Department Responds to Vacant Motel Fire

October 10, 2018

Bath Township Fire Department responded to a second alarm structure fire located at 1201 Neubrecht Road, Lima, Ohio, in Bath Township at 9:21 A.M. on 10/10/18. This address is the location of the former Lima Inn Motel which has been closed for about one and ½ years.

Upon arrival, firefighters observed heavy smoke coming from all four sides of the building which previously housed a gas station, convenience store, offices, restaurant, bar, and conference room.

The building suffered extensive heat, smoke, and water damage throughout. It took firefighters about 2 hours to fully extinguish the fire which was reported by a passing truck driver who dialed 9-1-1.

The Lima Fire Department provided mutual aid by sending two additional engine companies.

The property is owned by 1201 Neubrecht Rd Property LLC of Mentor, Ohio. Fire department officials were unable to locate contact information for the owner to notify them of the fire.

No fire department personnel were injured.
